

As the Association Council member of District 326, I got the opportunity to represent our District at the Association Council Meeting. I held an added responsibility in National Governing Body as the Honorary Association Secretary. It gives me immense pleasure to present my report as AC Member for the year 2019-20, briefing the activities and achievements at Association level.

A number of memorable events have ennobled my journey in Inner Wheel which stands for friendship and service. I tried to perform to the best of my ability whenever or wherever the need arose. Every step I took in the District Executive Committee with every passing year was an experience in itself. With great pleasure I recount the bygone year as below:

Incoming Chairmen's Institute (ICI):

The ICI for the District Chairmen 2019-20 "360° & Beyond" was held from 2nd April to 4th April, 2019 at Avadh Utopia Resorts, Vapi. It was hosted by District 306. I got the opportunity to attend the ICI as the incoming Hon. Association Secretary.

Installation of Association President 'Meraki':

At this ceremonial event, named 'Meraki', held on 16th June 2019 at Hotel 'The Oberoi Grand', Kolkata, hosted by Inner Wheel District 329, Association President 2019-20 Mamta Gupta was installed as 44th Association President. It was a great feeling for me too to have been installed as AC member and Hon. Association Treasurer and having participated in a spectacular flag parade. Association President 2018-19 Smita Pingale gave a comprehensive review of the year gone by and Association President 2019-20 Mamta Gupta presented the outlines of activities and events planned for the year ahead. The Chief Guest for the function was Hon'ble Governor of Meghalaya His Excellency Sri Tathagatha Roy. Delegates from India and abroad graced the occasion, including the galaxy of 4 Past IIW Presidents, 12 Past Association Presidents, 26 Association Council Members 2019-20 and 23 District Chairmen 2019-20. Presence of our own Patricia Hilton as IIW Board Director was an honour and privilege for our District.

First Association Executive and Association Council Meetings:

➤ First Association Executive Committee Meeting was held on 15th June 2019 at Hotel 'The Oberoi Grand', Kolkata. Important deliberations and discussions took place. Nominations were received for IIW Offices 2020-21, viz. PAP Dr. Bina Vyas for IIW President, IPAP Smita Pingale for IIW Board Director and PAP Dr. Rashmi Sharma and PAP Shashi Gupta for CCCC 2019-22. The nominations were opened, scrutinised and found valid.

➤ First Association Council Meeting was held on the 17th & 18th June at Hotel 'The Oberoi Grand', Kolkata. The newly installed AC Members participated in fruitful and purposeful deliberations. Election for the post of CCCC 2019-2022 was held. Dr. Rashmi Sharma was declared as the Association CCCC 2019-2022. Nominations for the post of IIW President (PAP Dr. Bina Vyas) and IIW Board Director (IPAP Smita Pingale) were announced.

➤ Both EC and AC Meetings were conducted efficiently by Association President Mamta Gupta. The Association EC and AC Members were overwhelmed by the warm hospitality, excellent arrangements and outstanding entertainment by the host district 329.

Zonal Meets – Milestones

'Milestones'- the Zonal 'Friendship and Cultural Exchange' Meets were organised in the four zones of the country under the able guidance of Association President Mamta Gupta, viz. North Zone Meet at Jammu (Host District 307) on 31-Aug & 1-Sep-2019, South Zone Meet at Mysuru (Host District 318) on 7 & 8-Sep-2019, West Zone Meet at Goa (Host District 317) on 14 & 15 Sep-2019 and East Zone Meet at Guwahati (Host District 324) on 21 & 22-Sep-2019. Cultural Programs by participating Districts, Rally on 'Mission Mamta', Talk Show, Ramp Walk, and Symposium were organised. Deserving Inner Wheel members and eminent women achievers were felicitated. District Chairmen presented their project dimensions. Association EC attended all the Meets. All the four meets were well organised.

NATIONAL MEET – Miration:

National Meet, 'Miration' was held on 17th and 18th November 2019 in the beautiful Ananta Resorts, Udaipur, hosted by District 305

IIW President Phyllis E Charter graced the event as the Chief Guest. Veteran Actor Raza Murad, Priyank Kanoongo (President NCPDR), Prashant Hartalkar, Gen Sec. VHP and MD of Swanath Foundation Shreya Bharatiya were the other guests.

- ♦ Five nominations were received for the post of National Editor, Nominations found valid were: 1. Sunita Jain IWD 305 ;2. Shashi Kir IWD 308; 3. Dr. Sandhya Bhat IWD 314; 4. Veena Swamy IWD 316; 5. Sushmita Sarkar IWD 329.

Second Association Council Meeting:

Second Association Council Meeting (2019-20) was held on 16th and 17th February 2020 at Hotel Silver Oak, Gurgaon, hosted by District 301. The synopsis of the meeting is:

➤ In her opening welcome remarks, the Association President Mamta Gupta graciously praised the functioning of both the Hon. Association Secretary Krishna Mohanty and Hon. Association Treasurer Rachna Agarwal. She also reported few achievements in her report:

- ♦ Mobile App of 'Mission Mamta - Orphan free India' was released by Eminent Actor Raza Murad and IIW President Phyllis E Charter at National Event Udaipur.
- ♦ Website - On the auspicious day International Inner Wheel Day 10th January 2020 Mission Mamta -Orphan free India 2024 Website was launched.
- ♦ History Book was released in National event at Udaipur to commemorate 65 years of Inner Wheel India. Quiz Book was also released in National Event in Udaipur.

- ♦ **Contribution for Civic Reception** - As discussed and passed in the First Association Council Meeting Rupees Seven lakh (for the Civic Reception during the IIW Convention in India) was handed over to Local Committee Coordinator PIIWBD Renu Baljee, IIW President Phyllis Charter and IIW President Elect Dr. Bina Vyas.
 - In her report as National Representative Mamta Gupta informed:
- ♦ **Margarette Oliver Golding Award**: She happily announced that IIW had accepted two nominations from India for the Margarette Golding award, viz. 1. PIIWP Abha Gupta (District 301) and Nagamma Keshavamurthy (District 316). Three more nominations from District 310, 306 & 314 were received and forwarded to IIW for consideration.
- ♦ **Visit of IIW President Alan Phyllis**: IIW President Alan Phyllis visited India from 4th November 2019 to 22nd November 2019
- ♦ **IIW Convention meeting**: IIW President Phyllis attended Local Convention Committee meeting for IIW Convention, to be held in 2021 at Jaipur. 2nd LCCC meeting took place at Udaipur.
 - Highlights of the report of Honorary Association Secretary Krishna Mohanty were:
- ♦ Ballots for the election of Association Vice-president and National Editor were sent to all the Club Presidents from the 2nd November 2019. Duplicate ballots were dispatched from the 9th January to 17th January 2020, as and when requested by the District Chairmen. Ballot Summaries were sent every week to all District Chairmen and AC Members with details of Ballots and Duplicate Ballots received and sent.
- ♦ Nominations for the post of Hon. Secretary and Treasurer for the year 2020-21 were called for.
- ♦ Five Nominations were received for the post of Honorary Association Secretary, Nominations found valid were: 1. Rajni Katia IWD 309, 2. Rohini Kansal IWD 310 3. Sarita Prasad IWD 325. 4 Sumita IWD 324. Nomination of Anuradha Nandakumar IWD 318 was found invalid.
- ♦ Two Nominations were received for the post of Honorary Association Treasurer. The Nomination of Rita Bhargava IWD 312 as found valid and nomination of Nanda Zadbuke IWD 317 was found invalid.
- ♦ **Analysis of balloting** :
Total number of Ballot papers sent – 1325, Number of Ballots received – 1183
Overall Voting percentage – 89.28%, Overall Valid Balloting – 93.92 %
 - Honorary Association Treasurer Rachna Agarwal presented the accounts of the Administration and Triennial Account and presented the statistics of membership at Association level for the year. Information of filing of income-tax return for AY 2019-20 was given. Audit Report of 15th Triennial Conference held at Pune in Feb-2019 was presented. Details of literature received and delivered were submitted.
 - PAP Forum Meeting was held on 15th November 2019 at Udaipur. CCC Meeting was held on 15th February 2020 in Gurgaon.
 - Ballots for the election of Association Vice-President 2020-21 and National Editor 2020-21 were opened and counted. The results announced by Association President Mamta Gupta were as follows:
 - ♦ Association Vice President & Deputy National Representative 2020-21: Saroj Katiyar of District 311
 - ♦ **National Editor 2020-21**: Dr. Sandhya Bhat of IWD 314
 - Updates of the National Project Mission Mamta to create an Orphan Free India is taken up in collaboration with National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR), Ministry of Women and Child Development (WCD) and Swanath Foundation.
 - Association Vice President 2019-20 Vasudhaa Chandrachud informed about the following events to be held in 2020-21:
 - ♦ Incoming Chairman's Institute will be held on 4th ,5th ,6th April 2020 (Sat, Sun, Mon) at 'International Center, Goa' in Panjim, Goa, hosted by District 317.
 - ♦ Installation of Association President 2020-21 will be held on Wednesday, 17th June 2020 at Mukesh Patel Auditorium, Juhu, Mumbai. 1st Association EC Meeting (2020-21) to be held on Tuesday, 16th June 2020 and 1st Association Council Meeting (2020-21) to be held on 18th and 19th June 2020.

- 5th South Asia Rally will be held in Dhaka, Bangladesh
- Updates regarding 18th IIW Convention 2021, being held for the first time in India were given.
- Discussion on 12 A Registration – Association President Mamta Gupta urged the members to take a proactive step and decide to register the Association as a charitable company under section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013, limited by guarantee and thereafter apply for Section 12 A of Income Tax and exemption from GST etc.
- Information on Association's Permanent Office was given and it was suggested by the Members to find a place which is accessible to all.
- Proposals & Amendments – IIW Convention: CCC Chairman PAP Dr. Rashmi Sharma informed that 25 Proposals had been sent from India out of which one Proposal from IWD 320 was accepted to be presented in the IIW Convention.
- Other Matters - Kerala Relief Fund and Pulwama Fund details were presented. The idea of Id- card for Inner Wheel Members was mooted.
- Post 2nd AC Meeting, Sumita Som (District 324) was declared elected as Hon. Association Secretary and Rita Bharagava (District 312) as Hon. Association Treasurer for the Inner Wheel Year 2020-21
