


### Message From AC Member

"Ekchotisikoshish", we have started below projects parallel by providing food and rashan:

- 1. Food to COVID patients and their families
- 2. Food to Daily wagers, labourers and Rikshawala
- 3. Providing rashan door to door.

People who are struggling due to COVID and their families keeping themselves isolated, we are reaching out to them and providing free food. We connected through whatsapp, messages and Facebook and make sure they are getting our full support. We take care all such micro things that food should have all nutrients, proper meal with sanitized packets. We change our menu on daily basis and include salad in every meal. We started from 10 packets in lunch and 10 packets in dinner, which go maximum approximately till 50 in each meal. They feel so relaxed and happy when we deliver our packages, such joy and relief gives us so much strength to work harder.

In this Pandemic most of the people our loosing their jobs, their savings and in fact some of the people are not getting enough food to survive. Hence we came forward and started an initiate to provide free food to those who can't afford even 2 times of food. Not only food but we provided rashan such as oil, chawal, dal, aata, sugar, chai etc. to them. Approximately it varies between 50-200 packets on a daily basis.
